Event Description:

The PAS for Reducing the Effects of Climate Change on the Fight against Hunger and Poverty is an instrument for governments and non-state actors to issue concrete and specific actions in support of the Belém Leaders’ Declaration on Hunger, Poverty and Human Centred Climate Action.

Stakeholders meet to discuss concrete actions to promote human-centred climate action for the fight against hunger and poverty.

Name of the Plan to Accelerate Solutions:

Plan to Accelerate Solutions for Reducing the Effects of Climate Change on the Fight against Hunger and Poverty: Climate-Resilient Social Protection and Smallholder Agriculture Finance Partnership

Expected Outcomes:

1. Coordinate and establish relevant baselines and track progress across the seven target areas of the Belém Declaration, with a view to a stocktaking by 2030, with interim progress to be assessed by 2028.
2. Mobilise national governments and their partners in bringing structured support, shared learning and better integrated finance to country-led, program-level implementation.
3. Define initial steps to establish a joint coordination mechanism (within the Global Alliance) to align programming between GAFSP, climate funds, MDBs, and partners.
